

10 newest hotels in San Francisco

Like that "new hotel" smell? Check out these new or newly renovated SF hotels

Whether you're looking to stay at a big brand hotel on points or seeking a chic boutique, these 10 new or newly renovated San Francisco hotels provide ample excuses to book a stay in the city by the bay this summer.

Of the list below, a few are yet to open but are taking reservations now, some debuted recently and others that came online last year merit a second look. (Note: Rates do not reflect the nearly 25 percent in taxes and fees the city charges hotel guests.)

9- Formerly a Best Western, the 221-room **Hotel Zoe Fisherman's Wharf** made a splash in this tourist-luring neighborhood when it debuted last year after a \$16 million metamorphosis. Rooms are neutral-toned with materials "inspired by luxury yachts" (I haven't been on one, so I guess I'll take their word for it.) Rates from \$212.
